EMERGENCY PLAN



Lost Diver:

- give the recall signal to the other divers underwater (constant metallic banging sound)
- inform **NAUTILUS TWO** Director Mr. Wahid: 7772381
 - Nautilus TWO provide ENOS which is the best tool to avoid such situation and it has a range of 10km to locate the lost Diver
 - Diving boat have to move from near the entry point to the estimated exit point, looking for bubbles or/and looking for the Diver
 - o The boat captain has to communicate with other boats around, to help with searching the lost Diver
 - o Call police and Coast Guard
 - o Call Air Taxi or TMA, with coordinates to search for the lost Diver

In case of a dive related accident:

- get the diver out of the water
- administer Oxygen and make the diver lay down on the Dhoni with the legs up
- give the recall signal to the other divers underwater (constant metallic banging sound)
- inform **NAUTILUS TWO** Director Wahid: 7772381
- Activate the EMS
 - call for speed boat / air taxi / TMA / if not available Nautilus Two heads to the nearest island / resort where medical facilities and speed boat is available
 - o transport the diver to the nearest DAN clinic
 - o inform DAN Bandos / DAN Kuramathi Doctors
 - if the diver is responsive connect him to the DAN Doctors and make the diver inform about his symptoms / if unresponsive inform DAN Doctors
